

Software and Service Information General Terms

- 1. **Applicability**. The terms contained herein apply to each Client.
- 2. **SaaS Clarification**. For clarity, the features and functionality to be provided by Benevity, as described in the <u>Product Descriptions</u>, include standard features and functionality generally offered by Benevity to other clients across our multi-tenanted SaaS platform (by design). The provision of any features or functionality that are not generally made available by Benevity to other clients will be subject to additional agreement between the Parties.
- 3. **Confidential and Proprietary**. No part of the Software and Service Information may be reproduced or transmitted by Client for any purpose, other than for purposes of Client's internal use of the System and Services as authorized in a valid Order Document.
- 4. **Global Restrictions**. When utilizing the System and Services, Client must comply with the instructions communicated by Benevity to Client regarding various local legal restrictions which may limit the participation of Participants in certain countries/regions, as required by applicable local law or regulations in such locations. Such instructions may be communicated by Benevity by way of posting updates here, ² and Client is responsible for monitoring such updates and complying.

If Benevity, Inc. is NOT the Licensor under the Order Document, then the following paragraph applies: The Licensor listed in the applicable Order Document represents that it is a direct or indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Benevity, Inc.  - c. "**Giving Programs**" means giving programs established by Client from time to time and which may include matching campaigns.
 - d. "**Foundation**" means third-party charitable foundations that work with Benevity and that are registered in the jurisdictions in which they are established and which utilize a "donor advised fund" or similar model.
 - e. "**Funding Entity**" means the Global Online Giving Foundation, a third party non-profit organization that works with Benevity.
 - f. "Localized Experience" means those country(ies) for which a localized experience is deployed for the Client Integration during implementation. A listing of the applicable Localized Experience(s) is included in the Launch Authorization document during implementation.
